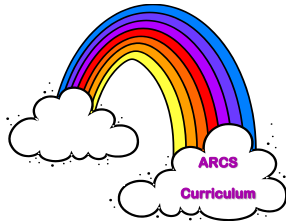

An outcome of the Government Green Paper was The Children's Act: 'Every Child Matters'. This contains significant requirements of children's services, which are important for the well being of children. It identifies 5 outcomes for every child:

1. to be healthy
2. to stay safe
3. to enjoy and achieve
4. to make a positive contribution
5. to achieve economic well being.

Since September 2021, all providers have been required to use the updated "Early Years Foundation Stage Framework" which sets out the standards of learning, development and care of children from birth to five. With these documents in mind we are, as parents and childminders, even more aware about our choice of provision for our children's upbringing.

As a school, we wish to offer parents support in making an informed choice regarding their school. We therefore have a user friendly prospectus and parent handbooks to fully inform prospective parents and carers.

We have also decided that we wish to support parents in choosing pre-school provision or 'child minding' facilities for school aged children – before and after school.

With this in mind, we have published the accompanying information about a range of child minders in the area, who we call 'Evelyn Childminder Network'. The school has worked with the child minders to produce information which parents will find useful.

Our school Early Years lead, holds training sessions when needed to help childminders keep at the 'cutting edge' of educational developments, and up to date with Evelyn's priorities.

In making your choice it is important that as parents you ask appropriate questions including:

- What are the standards of Health and Safety?
- Is the 'child minder' registered?
- Does the child minder offer healthy eating options?
- Is there provision to promote Maths and English development?
- As communication skills are a vital ingredient to support learning, is language development and enrichment promoted?
